

ERC Structure



The ERC Scientific Council

- 21 prominent researchers proposed by an independent identification committee
- President appointed by the Commission following recommendation of an independent committee
- Establishes overall scientific strategy
- Controls quality of operations and management
- Ensures communication with the scientific community

The ERC Executive Agency

- Executes annual work programme
- Implements calls for proposals
- Organises peer review evaluation
- Establishes and manages grant agreements
- Administers scientific and financial aspects
- Carries out communications activities



Reasons for Additional Budget



Additional funding could be for:

- (a) "start-up" costs for Principal Investigators moving to the EU or an Associated Country from elsewhere as a consequence of receiving the ERC grant and/or
- (b) the purchase of major equipment and/or
- (c) access to large facilities and/or
- (d) other major experimental and field work costs, excluding personnel costs." (WP2020, page 22)



What do you need to submit an ERC research proposal



- Design a research project to implement the idea
- Get a letter of support from a Host Institution
- Choose the right panel
- Select appropriate descriptors and keywords
- Select secondary panel if your proposal is interdisciplinary -> explain the inter-disciplinary nature
- Write the research proposal and submit electronically before the deadline!



Early registration and submission is strongly recommended

How ERC research proposals are evaluated



Excellence is the sole evaluation criterion



Contrary to what you may think.....



Established by the European Commission

- ✓ ERC funds "frontier research", including applied research.
- ✓ The budget is distributed among the scientific panels as a function of demand.
- ✓ The panel descriptors do not represent ERC scientific priorities.
- ✓ The success rate is virtually flat across the eligibility window (StG, CoG).
- The Host Institution is not an evaluation criterion.

#Tips for applicants: Questions to ask erc

European Research Council
Established by the European Commission

- Does it promise to go substantially beyond the state of the art (innovative)?
- Is it timely? (Why wasn't it done in the past? Is it feasible now?)
- What's the risk? Is it justified by a substantial potential gain? Do I have a plan for managing the risk?
- Why is my proposed project important?

Highlight and justify the high-risk & high-gain character

Be aware of the competitors

#Tips and advice if invited for an interview



Get Panel Members interested in you and your project
 Panel wants to see that these are your ideas, not of your supervisor

■ Don't try to guess who is in the panel – Waste of time

> Practice thoroughly

It is normal to be nervous

Transition of ERC to Horizon Europe



European Research Council
Established by the European Commission

- The calendar of the calls in 2021 will differ from the calendar of 2020 calls for proposals - Normal schedule expected by mid-2022
- Panel Structure
 - New: SH panel (SH7) "Human Mobility, Environment and Space" to cover the fields of human geography, demography, health, sustainability science, territorial planning and spatial analysis
 - New: PE panel (PE11) "Materials Engineering" to cover "Advanced materials development: performance enhancement, modelling, large-scale preparation, etc."
 - Small redefinitions of LS panels
- ERC Advanced Grant PI interviews at Step 2
- Most likely no SyG in 2021, expected to be back in 2022






ERC granted proposals






2018 Grantees by age and success rate

International Arrangements*

- Support researchers to temporarily join ERC teams in Europe.
- Following ERC calls for Principal Investigators (PIs) to express an interest in hosting scientists based in the participating non-European countries.
- Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, India, Japan, Korea, Mexico, Singapore,
 South Africa, the United States

Visiting Fellowship*

- •Visiting fellows commit to apply for an ERC grant in specified timeframe.
- Duration of visits: 1-6 months.
- Costs are covered by sending institutions.
- •Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Flanders, Georgia, Poland, Slovak Republic, Slovenia.

Eligibility window for 2020 calls

For the individual grants and possible extensions



- StG: PhD at least 2 and up to 7 years before 1 January 2020
- CoG: PhD at least 7 and up to 12 years before 1 January 2020

Extensions of eligibility window possible for documented cases of:

Before or after PhD

- Maternity 18 months per child
- Paternity actual time taken off

After PhD

- Military service
- Clinical training (max. 4 years)
- Caring for seriously ill family members

ERC and Open Access



- The ERC has reached a unanimous decision to follow a path towards Open Access implementation that is independent of cOAlition S activities
- This is in order to respect researchers' needs, especially the younger ones, to preserve equity among research communities and among European countries, with emphasis to countries with more limited national financial support for research.
- The ERC is working closely with the Commission to find solutions the allow the Open Access Rules under Horizon Europe to apply across all programs, including the ERC.
