



Figure 1. Hype Cycle for U.S. Healthcare Payers, 2018

Top Trends Affecting the Healthcare Industry: Gartner

Are you ready for the new trends?

The Gartner Institute asked **Strategy Officers** in various American Healthcare providers to rate the most important trends in the sector based on 3 criteria

Impact: How much each trend will affect them over the next 12 months

Velocity: How quickly the impact of each trend will be felt

Organizational readiness: How confident they are about their organizations' ability to cope with each trend

Less ready for

1 The <u>Consolidation</u> of the Healthcare system in USA will increase

Only 22% of the organisations was ready to deal with this trend within 12 months

Higher Impact

2 <u>Big Data</u> will provide information and Insights with higher <u>actionability</u> for the decision makers

Within a scale from 1-7, 1 having the higher impact, Strategists believe that this trend will have the higher impact

Fastest coming trends

3. U.S healthcare payment model alternatives will continue to expand(e.g. value-based payment models)

4 Focus on preventative care wil continue to increase

Strategists say their organisations will feel the impact of these trends in less than 3 months (in the end of 2019)

Greatest Opportunity/Threat

5 Consumers increasingly expect tailored messaging

Focus on personalised customer experience will increase (e.g. patient-centered care)


European Innovation Council Accelerator pilot

Proposals submitted | Cut-off 20 March 2020



Accelerator-SME Instrument Blended (Grant + Equity)

- Individual SMEs targeting new market with high-risk, high-growth potential
- Bottom up: all sectors



- **Grant € 0,5- € 2,5 mi**. (funding rate 70%)
 - All activities including commercialisation
 - 12-24 months (TRL > 6)
- Equity:
 - Up to €15 million, EC % < 25%
 - Activities above TRL 8 (mature solutions)
