


Ambitious rollout 2017-2020





Example in practice: **Innovation Assessment Tool**

- Common tool to benchmark academia in terms of knowledge triangle integration
- Simple and qualitative tooled validated in several regions of EU
- Connecting moderate innovation regions with core ecosystems in EU
- Testing in 2017, over 15 regions in 2018 pilot













Example in practice: Quick Flu Test

The test technology developed by SensDx facilitates quick identification of specific diseases and allows the user to:

- obtain precise information about the type of a developing condition
- establish a precise diagnosis
- commence the right therapy





Example in practice:

Post-stroke Monitoring Service for Patients and HCPs

- tool to allow post-stroke patients with difficulty walking to undergo self-rehabilitation at home, with remote follow up from a therapist
- Web-based solution that will reduce the rehabilitation costs by 35%
- Implementation will be simple due to integrated approach of tool for HCPs






















Interactive Hydration Controller



- Wearable textile band to monitor the level of hydration in physically active people, young children and seniors
- Simple to use and high accuracy in hydration level
- Ready prototype in trials with humans







- Establishing business connections with key healthcare companies also in view of future placement















- Easy to adapt in any university/incubator setting



















- Who can apply? Project Leaders must be a legal individual with tertiary qualifications (university graduates, professor or doctor).
- Other European countries are also encouraged to apply with projects

Caixalmpulse is an intensive acceleration programme for the creation of new products and companies in the health and life sciences sector. This programme is meant to start the translation of health research projects into a market product.

Caixa is looking to support projects for researchers from universities, research and technology transfer centres, hospitals, foundations and non-profit institutions, whose main activity is research from Spain and Portugal. Established companies are explicitly excluded.







Validate line places emphasis on validating products and services.


Our network of Living Labs and Test Beds provides entrepreneurs the means to test products throughout the value chain.

Headstart funding


- The purpose of the Headstart funding is to accelerate market entry and create new economic activity.

The EIT Health Headstart Funding Programme is suitable for micro and small enterprises*, spin-offs, and start-ups that have a well-developed prototype and are ready to launch a product. Company must be incorporated/registered before the subgranting agreement initiation



- To support the applicants in realizing next steps towards market and shorten time-to-market for innovative products and services
- To verify the need/benefit of the product/service for users/customers/payers/ partners
- To increase the possibility of attracting further private investment

• Regional selection. Selected startups will participate in the Innostars startup academy




